

## English-Language Testing Availability in the USSR and Eastern Europe

In response to requests from U.S. institutions about the availability of English language testing centers in Eastern Europe and the USSR, we have gathered the following facts. Students can acquire specific information about testing dates and site addresses by filing the appropriate registration forms and paying required fees to the offices below.

The TOEFL program is represented in the USSR by the American Council of Teachers of Russian (ACTR) based in Moscow. The ACTR staff is facilitating the testing process, and through their efforts the TOEFL test is now being administered in the USSR as follows:

1. In Moscow, on a monthly basis for the remainder of the 90-91 testing year.
2. In Leningrad, in March and May, 1991.
3. Testing arrangements are being made in Kiev.
4. Testing will begin in Vilnius, Lithuania in February 1991.

In the past, TOEFL has been administered regularly in most of East-Central Europe, although on a limited basis because testing was held only at the U.S. Embassy. Early in fall 1990, the Institute of International Education (IIE) East-Central Europe office was opened with Budapest as its base. This office will serve TOEFL applicants in Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland, Romania and Bulgaria. IIE will locate additional testing space, distribute bulletins, and identify and train appropriate testing staff.
