Protecting the integrity of your institution's screening and admissions processes is crucial. Take proper precautions to minimize the risk of receiving fraudulent documents.

Watch out for these red flags:

- Receiving a message from an email address that does not contain the wes.org domain (for example, wes@gmail.com)
- Receiving a message from an individual attempting to impersonate WES leadership
- Receiving an applicant's WES credential evaluation via email

Tips for safeguarding your institution:

Provide applicants with clear, consistent instructions for submitting required documentation.

- Question documents that look suspicious.
- Always require an official WES credential evaluation.
- Save a legitimate WES report as a sample for comparison purposes.
- Place a hold on the student's or candidate's account until all admission requirements are fulfilled.
